2nd Internet Fly-In a Hit, Weather Hit and Miss

Camp Atterbury, Edinburgh, IN—Flyers from across the Central US assembled at the Jackson County RC Flyers field for the 2nd Annual Internet Fly-In. The event was originally scheduled for June 7-8, but early birds arrived on the preceding Friday for some pre-event flying action.

Friday's weather brought occasional periods of rain, but pilots were able to fly in between the showers. Saturday started off with hazy, overcast conditions, but by afternoon the skies had cleared and participants enjoyed excellent flying weather right up until sunset. On Sunday, the skies threatened again early, but many of the hardier fliers were able to get several hours of flying in before the inevitable steady rains put the brakes on the activities for most of the day.

Nearly 90 pilots registered to fly in the event, with well over 200 planes on the field on Saturday. There was no shortage of flying activity. CD Carl Wilson set up five flight stations on the flight line, and each one was filled (with a wait list) for pretty much the entire day on Saturday. Raffle prizes were drawn throughout the day on Saturday.



Among the many notable attendees were Jeff Williams, Danny Snyder (JR/Horizon), Bob Snyder (Planes Plus) and Chris Hinson and his crew from Extreme Flight RC.

On Sunday morning, Jon Leyland arrived from Florence, KY and treated everyone to an amazing aerobatics demonstration with his see-through Radiocraft 35% Extra. Jon later went on to place 5th in the Frank Noll XFC competition in Troy, Ohio on June 22.
